

Hi, this is Mayor John Coiro.

As of this past Sunday night, we have seen a weekly increase of 47 confirmed cases of Totowa residents who have tested positive for the corona virus. While this figure is lower than the previous week, it is still too many. This brings our total confirmed positive cases since March to 548. So please be vigilant with the preventive measures you are all taking as we are seeing cases spike throughout the State of NJ.

Due to the increases of positive cases within the State, the Fire Truck parade originally scheduled for this Saturday, November 28 has been cancelled. This is a precautionary move as firefighters would have been coming from various municipalities around the State. The fire truck parade will resume in 2021. The Totowa and Woodland Park Fire Departments will be parading through the streets in Totowa on the evenings of December 15 and 16. More details will be announced as the date gets closer.

Our annual tree lighting ceremony will be virtual this year and will be held at 6:30 PM on Friday, December 4. The tree lighting will be an abbreviated ceremony without the school choir in attendance and will be broadcast on facebook.
